

CAN opens regional branch office of Deutscher Verband Nanotechnologie e.V.



End of 2011 the “Deutscher Verband Nanotechnologie (DV Nano) was founded.

The target of the organization is to generate closer connections of industry and scientific communities dealing with nano technology via its regional offices. Meanwhile regional offices have been founded in Saarbrücken, Göttingen, Karlsruhe and Köln. In Hamburg the information exchange between members of industry, science, civil society, administration and politics in north of Germany shall be sustained.

Dr. Frank Schröder-Oeynhausen and Prof. Horst Weller, the two CEOs of CAN GmbH, and managers of the Hamburg DV Nano-office justify the founding. “Nano technology meanwhile is related to many products in different branches. We intend to provide a stage to entrepreneurs, scientists, developers but also to users of nano technology to compare notes more intensively”, according to Schröder-Oeynhausen. And Prof. Weller adds: “It is logically consistent that northern Germanys nano scene will support the efforts of DV-Nano to tie the German competence in nano technology and to argue about this theme in an objective qualified way.” Dr. Ralf Nonninger, president of DV-Nano : “Regarding nano technology and nano science, different regions in Germany are focused on different key aspects. If we succeed in integrating these in one single organization, the complete competence multiplicity and the wide spectrum of this young discipline will be centralized in a single organization structure.”
